seminar as well as the lectures so as to advance the intellectual skills and understanding of the topic.

The module was heavily history based at the beginning which was not what I'd expected. Although I found this challenging to engage with at first, I did find it interesting. I could see the wider relevance to geographical themes. I found the spread of work good, but though that the word limit on the exam questions did not provide me with enough words to provide the indepth analysis required for a first grade mark. I would have preferred to have been given perhaps three questions to answer with a longer word limit for each to allow to me demonstrate my knowledge in more detail and more effectively.

I found the module website very useful, but would suggest that dates were put on the lecture schedule rather than week numbers as there were times it did not correlate with the university timetables.
